

7th CHANGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF DEFENCE STATUTES

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Article 1

7th change of the University of Defence Statutes

The University of Defence Statutes, registered by the Ministry of Defence on September 1, 2004, reference number 6035-83/2004-7542, as amended by the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th change, is to be changed as follows:

1. In Article 1, Clause 5 it is said:

„(2) The University of Defence (hereinafter referred to as “UoD”) is a part of an organizational state section of the Ministry of Defence, financed from the state budget, especially from the MoD chapter and handles allocated financial and material tools according to special legal regulations.

2. Article 14, including its heading says:

„Article 14

Course of the Admissions Procedure

(1) Applicants submit a written or electronic application to study in a study programme; he/she specifies the branch of study. The content requisites of the application are specified by the Rector. If the application is not filled in properly, the authorised workplace of the UoD or the Faculty will ask the applicant to do away with deficiencies within specified adequate term. If the applicant does not do away with the deficiencies within specified term, his/her application is considered not to be submitted. The admissions procedure is launched when the application form is delivered to the UoD, or a Faculty that realizes the corresponding study programme.

(2) If applicants applying for a study programme which prepares professionals for the needs of the Army of the Czech Republic, are not professional soldiers in their active service and submitted an electronic application, they are obliged to deliver a signed copy of the electronic application to the UoD or the Faculty that realizes the corresponding study programme within specified term. If the signed copy of the electronic application is not delivered in time, the authorised workplace of the UoD or the Faculty will ask the applicants to deliver it in specified term.

(3) Applicants will receive a written invitation to sit for the entrance examination. Applicants who excuse themselves for not sitting the entrance examination can be invited by the Rector or a Dean - according to where the particular study programme is accredited – to sit for the entrance examination in another term.

(4) The Rector determines the method of the admissions procedure, especially entrance examination documentation as well as documentation of other significant facts crucial for the admission is administered.

(5) The admissions decision for a study programme realized by the UoD is taken by the Rector. The admissions decision for a study programme realized by the Faculty is taken

by the Dean of the Faculty. The admissions decision is announced the applicants in accordance with § 50, clause 5. Together with the admission decision the applicants will receive other information concerning both the study and possibly the beginning of the military service. The admission decision is at the same time published on the official notice board of the UoD.

(6) The applicant may ask for a review of the decision in accordance with § 50, clause

(7) When reviewing a decision in accordance with § 50, clause 7 it is considered whether the decision was made in conflict with the law, UoD and Faculty internal directives, and rules valid for the particular study programme admissions procedure.”

3. In Article 16, Clause 2 it is said:

„(2) If the Ministry of Defence sets the admission procedure fees according to § 58, clause 1, applicants pay the fees via a fee stamp of corresponding value enclosed to the written application form, if they submitted a written application. Applicants pay the fees via bank transfer to the corresponding bank account if they submitted an electronic application. The amount of admission procedure fee and the method of payment is published under the terms of the admission procedure information (§ 49, Clause 5) “.

4. In Article 16, Clause 5 words “§ 58 Clauses 2 to 4“ are replaced by words “§ 58 Clauses 3 and 4“.

5. In Article 24 letter b) says:

„b) University Institute under section § 22, Clause 1, letter b) - Institute of NBC Defence,“.

6. In Article 28, Clause 1 says:

„(1) UoD financial sources are represented by financial means coming from the state budget allocated especially from the Ministry of Defence chapter (hereinafter “budget means”), possibly from other sources (hereinafter “off-budgetary means”)“.

Article 2

Final Provisions

(1) This 7th change of the University of Defence Statutes was approved according to § 9, Clause 1, letter b) by the University Senate in July 1, 2009.

(2) This 7th change of the University of Defence Statutes comes into force according to § 36, Clause 4, by the date it was registered by the Ministry of Defence according to regulations of § 95, Clause 8, letter a).

(3) This 7th change of the University of Defence Statutes becomes effective in September 1, 2009 except regulations of Article 1, letter 5 which becomes effective in January 1, 2010.
